End Year 6/30/26 Claims were submitted for payment:

Magistrate Mike Lockard and Magistrate Chad Patton ask about a claim presented by Logan Faulkner for a wheel hub assembly for a single axel dump truck in the amount of \$800.00. Judge Barnes told them Road Supervisor Patrick McCoy has tried several times to locate the needed parts and had no luck but did find a used hub assembly , an axel and housing locally. They priced the parts and the price was then negotiated. Judge Barnes told members of the court he would talk to Road Supervisor Patrick McCoy to make sure he could not find the parts elsewhere.

Magistrate Mike Lockard also questioned a claim submitted by Redline for the EMS. The claim listed oil change, air and cabin filters plus new wipers. Fiscal Court Clerk Connie Crabtree went and got a copy of the claim so they could look over it. Judge Barnes called EMS Director William Puckett so that he could explain the claim. William told them this claim was for EC 4 ambulance. When they took EC 4 ambulance in for the oil change and filters, they also checked the tires and fluids which are under our maintenance program. Judge Barnes, along with members of the court, told William to tell the vendor they would need to submit an itemized detailed check list with the claim they are submitting for payment from now on.

Magistrate Dennis Combs questioned a freezer we brought for the EMS Service from an individual . It will be used to keep bags of ice in case of emergencies. An invoice was submitted for this freezer. After discussion of the year end claims a motion was made by Magistrate Dennis Combs seconded by Magistrate Chad Patton with all members present voting in favor approving to pay all 6/30/26 year end claims.

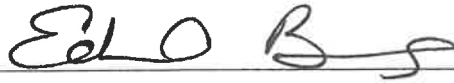
